Preface

The WV-CF334 is surveillance color CCTV camera equipped with a 1/3 inch CCD solid-state image sensor with 752 horizontal pixels.

This camera can be mounted on a ceiling or a wall without any difficulty.

Features

WV-CF334 is provided with the adaptive black stretch function, high resolution of 540 TV lines (horizontal), and minimum illuminance of 0.6 lx (C/L), 0.4 lx (B/W), (F1.3(WIDE)) thanks to the adoption of the newly developed digital signal processor.



Discolouration on the CCD color filter

When continuously shooting a bright light source such as a spotlight, the color filter of the CCD may have deteriorated and it may cause discolouration. Even when changing the fixed shooting direction after continuously shooting a spotlight for a certain period, the discolouration may remain.

Do not aim the camera at strong light sources.

A light source such as a spot light causes a blooming (light bleeding) or a smear (vertical lines)



Use this product for indoor use only.


Radio interference

Mounting screws

It is necessary to procure screws or bolts to mount the product. Prepare them according to the material and strength of the area where the camera is to be installed. The screws and bolts must be tightened with an appropriate tightening torque according to the material and strength of the installation area.

Major Operating Controls and Their Functions



① Video output connector


Composite video signals are transmitted. If this unit is connected to the multiplex unit, the multiplexed VD2 that is prioritized over INT is automatically selected.

② Marker

This marker is used when the top cover is installed.

3 Dip switch

Selects ON/OFF of white balance, backlight compensation, Adaptive Black Stretch or Simple day/night mode.



• Simple day/night mode selector [D/N]

 ON: The camera selects black-and-white mode if the picture is dark, or color mode if the picture is bright enough.
 OFF: Color picture is displayed normally.

Default setting: OFF

Note:

The simple day/night function is established by utilising the SENSE UP function for B/W images. The IR filter is secured.

Adaptive Black Stretch selector [B.S.]

ON: The dark area of the object is automatically corrected to lighten it.

OFF: Does not compensate.

Default setting: ON Important:

In the case of "ON" setting, noise may be increased in the dark area of the object

In addition, darkness and brightness may be emphasized in the vicinity of the boundary between the dark and bright areas.

• Backlight compensation selector [BLC]

ON: Compensates the background automatically if it is brighter than the object

OFF: This mode is used when the front of the object is extremely bright.

Default setting: OFF

Note:

Under some conditions, such as extremely strong backlight, the desired compensation effect may not be achieved even if the mode is set to ON to detect the backlight level.

White balance selector[ATW/AWC]

ATW: Activates the automatic color temperature tracking mode. The camera continuously measures the color temperature of the light source and automatically adjusts the white balance.

The adjustment of the color temperature ranges from approx. 2 700 K to 6 000 K.

AWC: Activates the automatic white balance control mode. This adjustment is suitable for a location where a light source is stable. The adjustment of the color temperature ranges from approx. 2 000 K to 10 000 K.

Default setting:ATW

4 Focus lock lever

Fixes the focus position after adjusting.

5 Zoom lock lever

Fix the zoom position after adjusting.

6 Azimuth adjuster

Adjusts the azimuth angle of the camera

7 Tilting table

Adjusts the tilting position of the camera.

8 Panning table

Adjusts the panning position of the camera.

Panning table lock screw [LOCK] Fixes the panning table.

10 Power cable

Supplies 24 V AC or 12 V DC from an external power source.

1) Monitor output jack (RCA jack)

Connects the LCD monitor and such devices for checking images.

Installations and Connections

The following installation should be made by qualified service personnel or system installers.

■ Preparations


Important:

• Procure 4 mounting screws according to the material of the installation area. In this case, wood screws and nails should not be used.

Recommended tightening torque is as follows:

M4: 1.6 N·m {16 kgf·cm}


- Required pull-out capacity of a single screw/bolt is 196 N {20 kgf} or more.
- If a ceiling board such as plaster board is too weak to support the total weight, the area shall be sufficiently reinforced.
- The protection sheet attached to the dome cover should be peeled off after installation.



Direct mounting

If the camera is directly mounted on a wall/ceiling, align the camera mounting position with the position of the hole through which the cables run and make the hole.

If no hole is made through a wall/ceiling and open wiring along a wall/ceiling is used, please remove the dust guard cap,take out the cable,don't forget put back the dust guard cap. Then process the cover so that the cables can be run through the side of the cover.



Using a two-gang junction box

When using a two-gang junction box (4"x4"), procure one locally that meets the dimensions in the figure.

Next locally procure four camera mounting screws suitable for the installation surface and structure of the wall/ceiling or two-gang junction box.

■ Disassembling the Camera

1. Peel off the protection sheet from the top cover.

Don't remove completely as this protects the dome during installation.



2. Remove the top cover.

- Screw off the screw for fixing the top cover.
- Adjust the marker on this unit to "I" on the top cover, and turn the top cover counter-clockwise to remove it.
- The clear dome cover and the inner dome cover are joined into a single unit. Therefore, never try to remove them.




Top cover fixing screw (M3)

To mount the camera directly on the wall/ceiling

- 1. Prepare the mounting space.
- Place the camera onto the wall/ceiling and mark four screw positions with a pen.
 Mount the camera onto the wall/ceiling with 4
- screws (procured locally).
- 4. Fasten all of the mounting screws.

To mount the camera on a two-gang junction box

- Install the two-gang junction box onto the wall/ceiling.
- 2. Mount the camera onto the two-gang junction box with 4 screws (procured locally).
- 3. Fasten all of the mounting screws.



The mounting requirements are shown as follows.

*Make sure that the installed mount bracket can support more than 5 times of the weight of the camera

■ Connections

● Video output connection

Important:

When connecting the coaxial cable to the video output connector, make sure that the connector of the coaxial cable is locked firmly.

Connect the video output connector to the monitor, or other system devices, with the procured coaxial cable.


The maximum extensible cable length is shown in the table.

Power connection

Connect the three-conductor cable of thecamera to the power supply. The wire colours and functions are shown in the table.

Wire colour	12 V DC	24 V AC
Brown	Positive	Live
Blue	Negative	Neutral
Green/yellow	Grounding	Grounding



Caution:

Be sure to connect the GND (grounding) lead of the camera and grounding terminal of the power supply when using a 24 V AC power source.

● Cable Length and Wire Gauge 24 V AC

The recommended cable length and thickness are shown in the table for reference. The voltage supplied to the power terminals of the camera should be within 19.5 V AC and 28 V AC.


■ Image Adjustment

1. Pan, tilt and azimuth adjustment Important:


- Do not touch the iris motor. Failure to observe this may cause trouble.
- Do not hold the camera by the lens unit when adjusting panning, tilting, or azimuth.


At the same time as the pan and tilt adjustments, make the zoom and focus adjustments in Step 2.

- 1) Rotate the panning table to adjust the panning position of the camera. (Range: 320°)
- The adjusting range is from +180° (clockwise) to -140° (counterclockwise).
- Tighten the panning table lock screw after adjusting.



- ② Rotate the tilting table to adjust the tilting position of the camera (Range: ±75°).
- This lens can also be rotated in the reverse direction, but the image azimuth is reversed. In such a case, turn the panning table to the 180° side to correct the azimuth image.
- When used at an angle that is close to horizontal, it must be noted that the shadow of the dome cover may be projected.




③ Rotate the azimuth adjuster to adjust the azimuth angle of the image (Range: $\pm 100^{\circ}$).



2.Zoom and focus adjustment

At the same time as adjusting the pan and tilt(Step 2), adjust the zoom and focus.

② Focus lock lever



- Loosen the zoom lock lever and move the lever between TELE and WIDE to obtain the appropriate angle of view. Tighten the zoom lock lever.
- ② Loosen the focus lock lever and move the lever between FAR and NEAR to obtain the optimum focus. Tighten the focus lock


Note:

To change the angle of view by moving the zoom lock lever, also move the focus lock lever to adjust the focus.

■ Assembling the Camera

1. Mount the top cover.

① Adjust the marker of this unit to "I" on the top cover to install the top cover.



Adjust the inner dome.

Rotate the top cover clockwise to adjust the marker to "II".

Turn the dome cover block to the right and left, watching the monitor. Make adjustments so that no eclipse is caused.




Important:

For inner dome adjustments, adjust the marker to the position of "II".

If the dome cover block is moved with unreasonable force, it may break.

3 Rotate the top cover clockwise to adjust the marker to "III".



2. Fix the top cover and the camera main unit by means of an accessory fixing screw (M3).
